

Measuring Risk

The needs of Te Awa’s cohort continue to increase in risk and complexity. Taiohi receiving our service are at great risk of serious harm to themselves and others. Each taiohi that received our wraparound service in the 22/23 year was graded on the matrix below to produce the following tables.

Catastrophic (a score of 25) is defined as the potential to cause life threatening harm up to and including death.

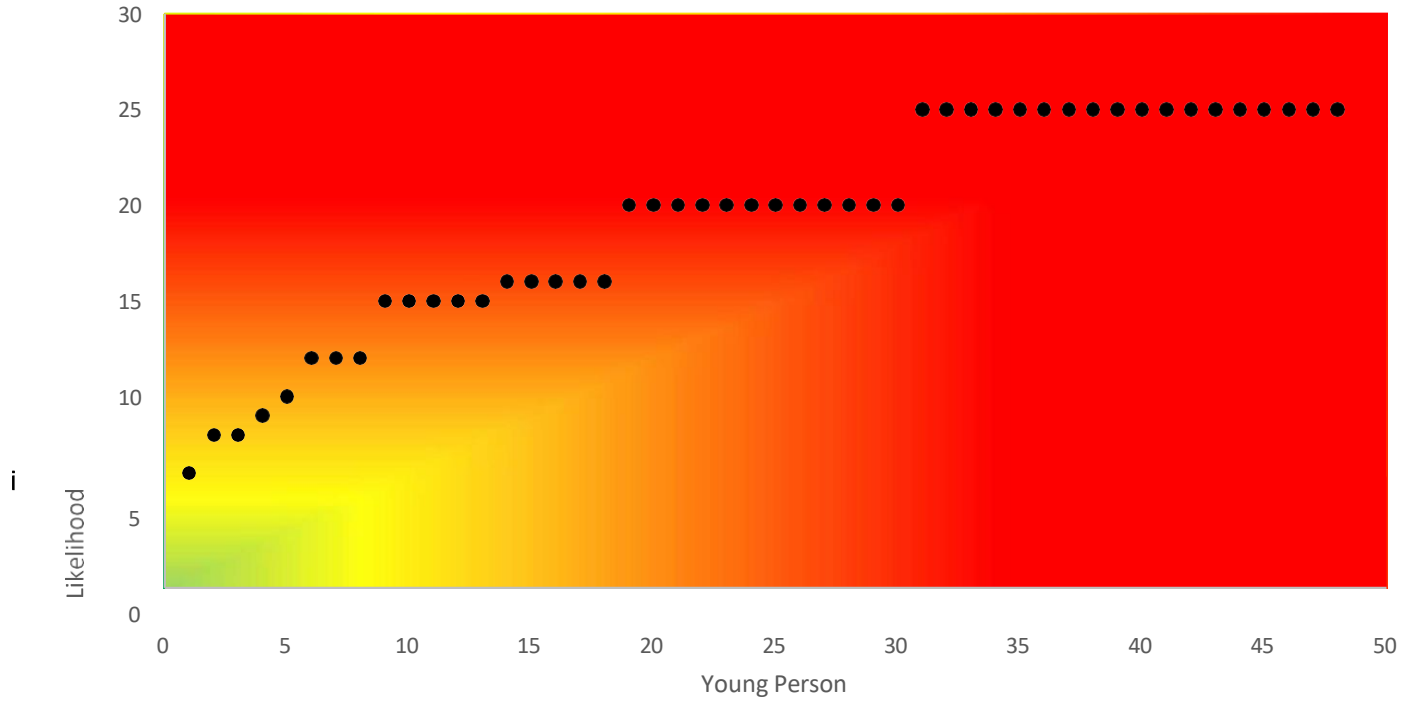

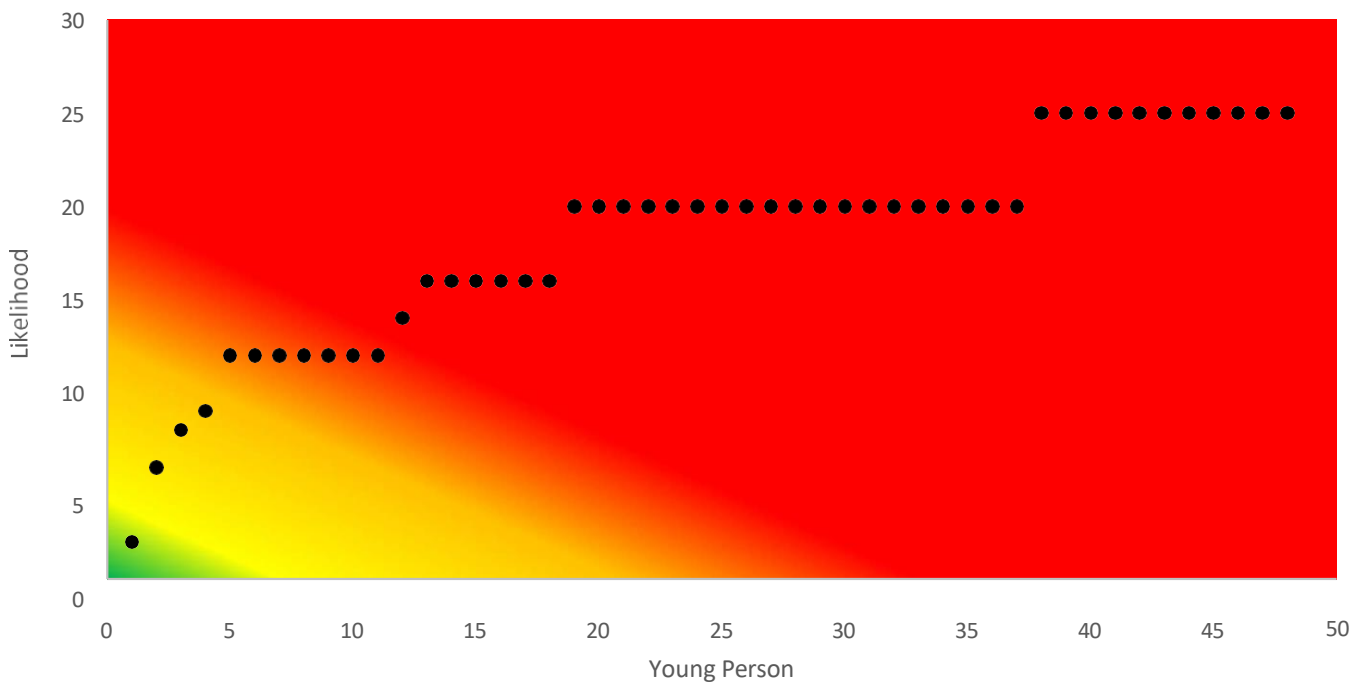


Cohort Heat Map Data
